Overview of opioid litigation and settlements

OAG has secured total \$12M+

- McKinsey (Feb. 2021) –\$279k
- J&J (July 2021) –\$2.2M
- Distributors (July 2021) –\$9.6M
- Mallinckrodt - \$73k (Pending)

Proposed opioid antagonist legislation

Broaden access to Naloxone

Core strategies from settlement includes:

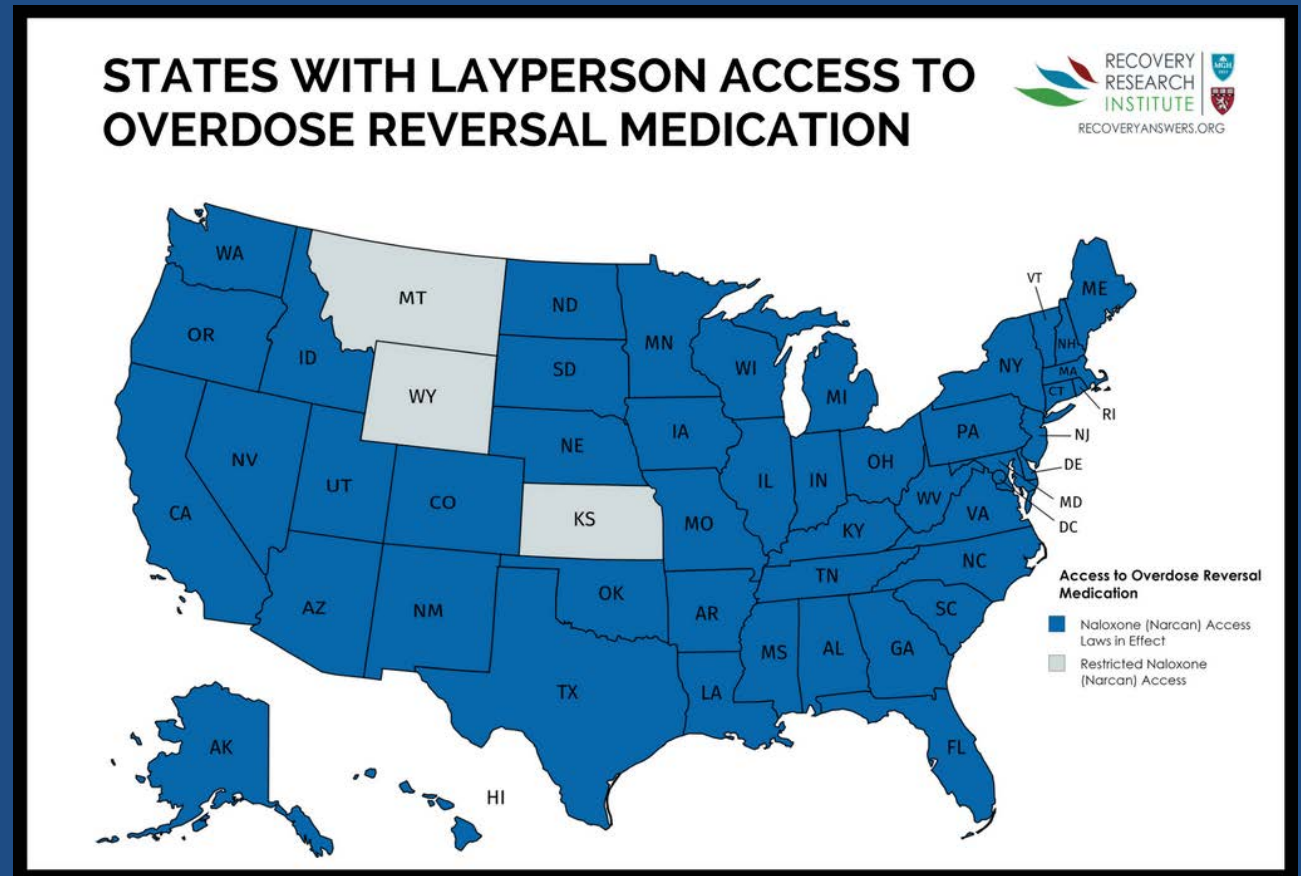
- increasing the availability of naloxone—a medication approved by the FDA to reverse opioid overdoses—particularly among vulnerable groups who may be uninsured or underinsured.
- expanding naloxone distribution and training for first responders, schools, community support groups, and families.

Survey for Community Members

Online Survey. Prevention & Treatment of Substance Use Disorder

- Identify how they've been impacted by Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) or any co-occurring Substance Use Disorder (SUD), and how they have seen their communities impacted,
- Share information about the Opioid Prevention and Treatment Act and rank program strategies by level of importance,
- Identify additional community resources,
- Identify additional community needs.

1. Notice of Funding Availability - November 2022
2. Applications Available – November 2022
 - Organization/Agency Overview
 - Detailed program goals and implementation plan
 - Detailed spending plan
3. Application Deadline – rolling
4. Award Announcements – January 2023
